

Only Jesus Can Save Hebrews 7

Scripture focus: Hebrews 7:23-28 Memory verse 7:25

- In God's economy
 - There was required an intermediary between Himself and man
 - The intermediaries were chosen by God
 - The intermediary presented sacrifices for sin
 - For the people and themselves
- The intermediaries died
 - As a result, there have been many before Christ Jesus
- Then there was the Christ
 - A new intermediary
 - Chosen by God—Sent and born a man
 - He entered the priesthood
 - He made a sacrifice for the sins of mankind
 - A perfect sacrifice—sinless—Himself
 - The difference--He remains forever
 - His priesthood is permanent
- He can do something no other can do
 - He can save those who come to God through Him
 - ALWAYS
 - And He now lives to intercede for those who come to God
- We need a priest just like Him
 - Holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and exalted above the heavens
- He doesn't spend his time offering sacrifices every day
 - As high priests do
- Christ Jesus did it ONCE
 - When he sacrificed Himself
- The Law
 - Appoints weak men as high priests
- The Promise of the Oath Hebrews 6:16-20; 7:18-21
 - Note this: Which came after the Law
 - Appoints a SON
 - Perfected FOREVER
