

Faith Defined Hebrews 11

Scripture focus: Hebrews 11:1-7

- Faith is
 - The assurance of things hoped for
 - The conviction of things not seen
 - Action based on a faith supported by confidence
- By faith—The ancients gained approval with God
- By faith
 - We understand creation
 - Things we see
 - Made by the word of God
 - From that which isn't seen
- By Faith
 - Abel offered God a better sacrifice than Cain
- By faith
 - Abel obtained a testimony of being a righteous man
 - God accepted his gifts
 - Yet dead, he speaks now by his faith
- By faith
 - Enoch was taken up
 - That he might not taste death
 - Enoch was gone and could not be found
 - Enoch's faith received God's approval
- Without faith
 - It is impossible to please God
 - For the one that draws near
 - Must faithe God exists
 - And faithes He rewards those seeking Him
- By faith
 - Noah
 - After God warned him (the WORD given)
 - About the coming rain (What is rain?)
 - Motivated by Godly respect (he faithed God's word)
 - Built a useless ark (man's view)
 - To deliver his family
- By faith
 - Noah condemned the world
 - And became an heir of righteousness
