

Jeremiah 3:1-25 Judah's Sins

- Jerusalem lacks for even one righteous man 1-3
 - God condemns; Jeremiah concurs
 - no righteousnessC God says
 - hard heartedC Jeremiah says
- Jeremiah defends the poor and then attacks leadership 4-6
 - In full accord the law is broken
 - Transgressions are many
 - Apostasy: time after time
- There is no reason for pardon 7-9
 - Jehovah God forsaken
 - Sworn by other gods
 - Ignoring God=s blessings and provision
 - Committing adultery
 - Even went to the harlot=s house to commit adultery
- Tear out the vine rows, strip out the branches 10-13
 - In pride, two houses, ignored God=s word of judgment
- God speaks judgment against the House of Israel 14-17
- God speaks a promise of hope to the house of Israel 18-19
- God speaks further about Judah=s sin 20-29
 - Otolaryngologist required
 - Lack of respect and reverence for God
 - Despite blessing they do not repent
 - Rebellious
 - Sin has driven away good
 - Materialistic
 - Full of deceit
 - Orphans and the poor ignored (no justice)
- The people appall God 30-31
 - False prophets
 - Priests acting on their own authority
 - The people loving it
 - God says: See you later, what will you do in the end?
