

Jeremiah 5:1-31 Again God Recalls Israel and Judah's Sin

- Jerusalem lacks for even one righteous man 1-3
 - God condemns; Jeremiah concurs
 - No righteousnessC God
 - Hard heartedC Jeremiah
- Jeremiah defends the poor and then goes to leadership 4-6
 - In full accord the law is broken
 - Transgressions are many
 - Apostasy: time after time
- There is no reason for pardon 7-9
 - God has been forsaken
 - The people now swear by other gods
 - Ignoring God=s blessings and physical provision
 - Committing adultery
 - Even going to the harlot=s house
- Tear out the vine rows, strip out the branches 10-13
 - In pride, two houses, ignored God=s word of judgment
- God speaks judgment against the House of Israel 14-17
- God speaks a promise of hope to the house of Israel 18-19
 - It will not be a total destruction
 - But you will serve strangers in a land that's not yours
- God speaks further about Judah=s sin 20-29
 - Otolaryngologist required: Bad Ears and Eyes
 - Lacking respect and reverence for God
 - Despite God's blessing they do not repent
 - Cardiologist Required—Stubborn and Rebellious hearts
 - Sin has driven away good-Materialistic-Full of deceit
 - Orphans and the poor ignored
- Judah appalls God 30-31
 - False prophets
 - Priests acting on their own authority
 - The people loving it
 - God says: See you later, what will you do in the end?
