

Jeremiah 8:4-9:6 Judah's Blindness & Jeremiah Laments

- Judah's Eyesight Problems 4-17
 - Spiritual Blindness v. 4-6
 - Unnatural behavior—they fall down and don't pick themselves up, they actually turn without repenting 4
 - Continual apostasy 5-6
 - Look at nature, the birds understand the seasons v. 7
 - But MY people don't know my ways Matt. 6:21-24
- Religious Blindness v. 8-11
 - False faith in religious leaders, the law and the temple
 - Lack of shame
 - Greedy, practicing deceit, false healing
- Moral Blindness v. 12-17
 - God seeks a recognition of shame—finds none 12
 - Judgment is again spoken against Judah 13
 - Doom awakens Judah, but not to repentance 14-17
 - Ezekiel 6:9; Isaiah 5:21; Judges 21:25
- Jeremiah Laments v. 8:18-9:6
 - Sorrow 18
 - Brokenness and dismay 21
 - The Lord God's healing rejected 22
 - Tears flow 9:1
 - Desire to run away from Judah 2
 - Desire to give up painful treacherous relationships 3
- The Lord God weighs in 4-6
 - Liars—all
 - Moving from evil to evil
 - They do not know ME
 - No trust, even within family units
 - Slander among neighbor's common
 - They weary from committing sin
 - They refuse to know ME Jer. 9:24
