God Remembers His Covenant - Jeremiah 11:1-23

- God's Covenant with Israel remembered v.1-5 Ex. 24:3-8, 32:11-14
 - God adds a twist to the covenant
 - Cursed is the man that doesn't remember
- Hear the words of this covenant and do them v. 6-8
 - I persistently warned your fathers
 - Listen to My voice
 - They did not obey or incline their ear
- Judah forms a conspiracy against God v. 9-13
 - They have turned their backs
 - They refuse to hear MY words
 - They have gone after other god's to serve them
 - Both the House of Israel and the House of Judah
 - They have broken the covenant
- God speaks to Jeremiah v. 14-17
 - Do not pray for the people nor cry out for them
 - I will not listen
 - Do the people deserve to be in MY house?
 - In light of their evil deeds
 - I planted you...I can take you out
 - Israel and Judah, you...
 - Provoked ME by making sacrifice to the Baals
- God reveals the plots against Jeremiah v. 18-20
 - Jeremiah says he was naïve
 - Like a sheep on the way to slaughter
 - Jeremiah appeals to God's righteous judgment
 - Go ahead—take vengeance on them
- God turns on Jeremiah's home boys to punish them v. 21-23
 - All the people of Anathoth will be utterly destroyed Jer. 1:1
 - Men by the sword
 - Women and children by famine
 - Why?
 - Because they told Jeremiah to not speak the "word of the Lord"
 - Or they would kill him
