

Judah's Drought - Jeremiah's Intercessions

Jeremiah 14:1 - 15:9

- Drought in Judah v. 1-6
 - The drought conditions bring shame
- Jeremiah's First Intercession v. 7-12
 - Judah's sin testifies against her
 - Why are you a stranger, Oh savior?
 - We are called by your name!
 - God refuses the cry of Judah
 - He will remember their sin
 - God tells Jeremiah to quit praying for Judah
 - God won't listen
 - there is no acceptable sacrifice
 - only destruction: sword, famine and pestilence
- Jeremiah's Second Intercession v. 13-18
 - Jeremiah talks about mixed prophetic messages
 - God condemns false prophets and priests for the confusion
 - False visions, divination, futility, self-deception
- Jeremiah's Third Intercession v. 14:19-15:9
 - Jeremiah appeals to God for mercy
 - God sends Judah away
 - to death
 - to the sword
 - to famine
 - or to captivity
 - God appoints them to four types of doom
 - sword
 - dogs to drag their bodies away
 - birds to eat them
 - beasts to eat them
 - Manasseh's sin typifies Judah's corruption
 - Idol worship v. 3 2 Kings 21
 - God will destroy Judah and will not relent v. 5-9
