

Jeremiah 28 Hananiah Counsels Rebellion

- Jeremiah's Conflict with Hananiah 28:1-17
 - Hananiah prophesized v. 1-4
 - Nebuchadnezzar's yoke will be broken
 - return of temple vessels
 - return of the exiles
 - return of Jeconiah
 - Jeremiah responds to Hananiah v. 5-9
 - I wish it were so
 - But peace requires fulfillment
 - We'll see what prophet is right
 - Hananiah acts and repeats v. 10-11
 - He breaks the yoke that Jeremiah is wearing
 - Jeremiah 27:2
 - And adds, that Nebuchadnezzar will be broken in all nations in two years
 - The Lord God speaks to Hananiah v. 12-17
 - That wood yoke it's now going to be iron
 - Nebuchadnezzar is my servant
 - even the wild animals will serve him
 - You're a liar
 - and you make the people trust a lie
 - Even worse you counseled rebellion against the LORD
 - You will die this year
 - and so it was - two months later
- Teachable moment: Don't speak for God until you're spoken to!
