

The Title Deed-Hope for Jerusalem's Restoration

Jeremiah 32

- Jerusalem and Judah's fate is sealed v. 1-5
 - Jeremiah put in the guard house
 - Jerusalem is surrounded and under siege
 - Jeremiah acts in faith
- Jeremiah redeems the land in Anathoth v. 6-12
 - The law of the kinsman redeemer Ruth 4
 - capable to redeem by relationship-kin
 - has to have the price to be paid
 - has to want to redeem it
 - has to actually pay the price
- Jeremiah's full faith in God is revealed v. 13-25
 - Jeremiah acts in faith
 - God promises the restoration
 - Jeremiah affirms God's power & faithfulness
 - Creation
 - Mercy, grace and justice
 - Rewards each individuals deeds
 - Power proven by signs and wonders
 - Redeeming Israel out of Egypt
 - Gave them the promised land
 - Promised judgment is at hand
 - Then yet, a promise of restoration too
- God confirms His righteous and deserving judgment v. 26-35
 - Jerusalem and its people deserved His wrath
 - Rebellious
 - Turned their backs on God
 - Engaged in improper worship
 - Idols
 - Baal worship in the temple
- God promises a new covenant v. 36-44
 - My people, and I will be their God
 - Fear God always
 - One heart and one way
 - Covenant is everlasting
 - Joy for God to do good for them
 - Full restoration of the land
 - buying and selling
 - Full restoration of Israel's fortunes
