- A Vision of God v. 1-3
  - Jeremiah in the guard house, still
  - Divine revelation for Jeremiah, difficult things
  - Jehovah is His Name, by which He revealed Himself Job 11:7
- A Vision of Restoration v. 4-9
  - Jerusalem under siege, chaos everywhere
  - Bodies thrown into the rubble to thwart the Chaldeans
  - Despite the rebellion, a promise is made
    - health and healing
    - peace and truth
    - restored fortunes
    - cleansed from iniquity
- A Vision of Prosperity v. 10-13
  - Voice of joy and gladness
  - Voice of the bride and groom
  - Voices of people giving Jehovah:
    - thanks
    - praise for His good
    - praise for His lovingkindness
  - Thanks offerings being brought to the LORD
  - Millennial kingdom
    - habitation of shepherds
    - flocks under the Messiah=s hand who numbers them
- A Vision of Messiah v. 14-26
  - In the time of promise
    - The righteous branch of David
    - Justice and righteousness—worldwide
    - Judah saved
    - Jerusalem dwelling in safety
    - Jerusalem=s name will be changed
      - \* YHWH Tsidkenu
    - David will not lack a man to sit the throne Ps. 89:19-37
    - Nor Levites to offer sacrifices continually
    - This covenant made to David will fail if my covenant of night and day can be broken Genesis 1:3-4
