

John's Testimony About Jesus - John 3:22-36

- John and Jesus are now baptizing
 - Jesus in Judea—A continuation of John's baptism
 - John 4:1-3
 - John in Aenon—Repentance
- John's disciples dispute with a certain Jew
 - About purification? What's this!
 - Competition and Comparison
 - Acts 19:1-5
 - Question: was John's baptism still efficacious?
- John gives testimony (a faithful witness)
 - I told you I'm not the Christ
 - Jesus came from heaven v. 30
 - I'm here from the earth
 - I was sent before Him so you would know He's here
 - I received the Authentication
 - No one can receive if it's not given by God
 - He is the bridegroom—I'm just the best man—He was here to claim His bride
 - He MUST increase—I must decrease, 3x v. 7, 14, 30
 - You consider me special—But He is the ONE for which I exist
 - John 1:26, 33
 - What He has seen He testifies to—but rejected by man
 - He speaks the words of God and gives of the Spirit without measure
 - The Father loves the Son and granted Him all authority
 - He who faiths the Son has eternal life
 - But the one without faith and obedience (faith) to the Son will not see LIFE, and the WRATH of God rests on him already
