

The Journey of Faith from Judea to Galilee - John 4:1-30

- First Stop—Sychar, Samaria II Kings 17
 - Weary Jesus stops to rest at a well outside town
 - The disciples go to town to seek food
- A woman comes to the well to draw water v. 1-30
 - Jesus speaks to her, “Give Me a drink”
 - She responds, “How is it that YOU, being a Jew” 4:27
 - Jesus, “if you knew” “you could have asked FOR LIVING WATER”
 - She responds again, “You don’t have a rope or bucket”
 - And the well is deep—hard to find “living water”
 - Are you greater than our Father Jacob who gave us this well?
 - Jesus says, “Jacob’s water only quenches thirst temporarily,
 - My water drinkers will never thirst and in them the water wells up into eternal life”
 - She says, “give me this water, I’m tired of walking to the well” John 3:4, Matt. 13:20-21
 - Jesus says, “Go get your Hubby”
 - She says, “I have no husband”
 - Jesus says, “Correct, however 5 and working on 6”
 - She says, “you must be a prophet” But she defers the conversation in religious comparison. “You people believe”
 - Jesus says, ‘Worshiping God is done in spirit and truth” “ an hour is coming, worship is going to be changed!”
 - She says, “I know the Messiah is coming”
 - Jesus says, “I that speak to thee, I AM!
 - Faith explodes in her, she leaves the water pot and runs to tell others, “Come see Jesus, is He not the Christ?”
