

We Want a King - John 6:1-40

- Jesus draws a large crowd wanting healing, and it gets late
 - Disciples: Let's go, just leave them
 - Philip: It will take 200 denarius to feed this crowd
 - Andrew brings a lad to Jesus
 - He came packing lunch, what possible good will this do?
 - Jesus: Takes the lunch, gives thanks to the Father, blesses it
 - Jesus feeds 5000 men ++, 12 baskets of bread are left over
 - The magnitude of this miracle was significant
 - Peoples response: want to make Jesus our King
- Jesus sends His disciples away and goes to be alone on Mt. Arbel
 - The disciples row a boat from Tiberius to Capernaum
 - A storm comes up while rowing
 - Jesus walks on the water to get to Gennesaret, 3.5-4 miles
 - Jesus scares them half to death
 - AFTER Jesus comforts them, they finally let Him in the boat
 - The crowd wants to know how Jesus got there, head scratcher?
- Jesus addresses the gathering crowd seeking Him v. 25-40
 - You ignore the signs and come seeking food from me
 - Do not work for food that perishes when the Son of Man will give eternal life
Isaiah 55:2
 - What work must we do?
 - The only work of man is to faith Me
 - If that is so, show us a sign! God gave our fathers manna!
 - God gave the manna from heaven not Moses
 - I AM the bread of (eternal) life, I have come down from heaven
 - Here is the Father's will—whoever beholds Me and faiths Me will have eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day
