John 13 Passover - I gave you an example

- Jesus' hour had come
 - Jesus knowing: John 5:19; 6:38; 7:16; 8:50; 14:24
 - He LOVED His own even to the very end
 - All things were given unto His hands
 - He was going home, from where he'd come
 - The devil has planted sedition in Judas' heart
 - o Gathered with His disciples at dinner
 - o Jesus insists on teaching again
 - Jesus humbles himself and washes His disciples feet
 - You call Me Rabbi and Master, it's true I AM
 - Do you know what I have done to you?
 - Pay attention—For I gave you an example
 - No slave is greater than his Master
 - Serve one another with humility Phil. 2:8; 1 Peter 5:5; 2 Cor. 8:9
- From now on v. 19-20
 - o I will tell you everything in advance, before it happens
 - I want to grow your faith! That you will know I AM Christ
- Jesus speaks of betrayal v. 21-30
 - One of you will betray me!
 - The disciples become perplexed (troubled)
 - At Peter's behest, John asks Jesus, who is it?
 - o Jesus dips a morsel in wine and hands it to Judas Ps. 41:9
 - Satan then entered into Judas, and they leave
- Jesus teaches the eleven v. 31-38
 - Now is the Son of Man glorified and the Father glorified in Him 12:23
 - o If God is glorified in Him, God will glorify Him in Himself, immediately
 - Where I Am going you cannot come, I told others, I tell you
 - A new commandment I give you—LOVE ONE ANOTHER
 - By example—the way I loved you
 - o Peter, no LORD, I will die with you
 - Jesus tells Peter that he will end up denying Him 3 times.
