

## The Garden - John 18:1-27

- Three different Garden Experiences
  - First Adam vs. the Last Adam 1 Cor. 15:45
    - First one cast out and Jesus pulled out
  - The last Garden experience Rev. 21-22
  - The Brook Kidron—Dusky, Gloomy
    - Dark most often from the blood of sacrifices
  - Gethsemane—Oil press
    - Jesus would soon suffer the pressure of the olive and wine press
- Rejected and Betrayed
  - Jerusalem and Judas, just like David
  - Judas brings a Roman Cohort to the garden
    - Judas expecting a deception betrays Jesus with a kiss Matt. 26:48-49
  - Whom do you seek? Response; Jesus the Nazarene
  - Jesus speaks boldly, I AM HE! I AM JEHOVAH
    - The Roman Cohort falls back to the ground
      - Divine power: the cohort were struck by His bearing
      - Jesus was in control of the situation not them
- Peter declares war and attacks a slave with a sword
  - Peter actually declares war on the will of God
  - Jesus however has a cup—reflecting His full submission Matt. 26:39; Ps. 40:8
  - Jesus rights the wrong and heals the poor lads ear
- Jesus is taken to Annas' house
  - Informal and illegal hearing conducted
- Jesus taken to the chief priest
  - Peter and another disciple following along
    - The other disciple is known by the chief priest
    - The other disciple brings Peter into the courtyard
- Peter
  - Counsel's with the ungodly
  - Stood with Jesus' enemy
  - Sat with Jesus' enemy
    - Managing three unique denials for knowing and following Jesus
  - Peter had been burnt by the fire
- The cock crows: Jesus was in total control
  - Luke 22:32, 61
