

Crucified, Dead, and Buried - Mission Accomplished

John 19:17-42

- Crucified v. 17-27
 - Pilate turns over Jesus to the Jews
 - Jesus is forced to carry his own cross (required of criminals)
 - Pilate writes out His crime
 - Jesus of Nazareth: King of the Jews
 - The Jews object, but Pilate will not be moved
 - Jesus is marched to Golgotha hill
 - Two other men were crucified alongside Jesus that day
 - The soldiers took Jesus' garments casting lots for His tunic Psalm 22
 - Jesus was nailed to the cross
 - Jesus is surrounded by 4 women and John at the foot of the cross
 - Jesus transfers His responsibility for His Mother to John
- Dead v. 29-30
 - Jesus is fully in the will of His Father
 - Three hours, agony, separation from His Father, darkness, isolation
 - Suffering our rightful death—Psalm 69:3-4
 - A soldier offers Jesus sour wine
 - Jesus speaks His last: "IT IS FINISHED"—*tetelastai*
 - Notably: It will always be finished
 - Ex. 12:46; Num. 9:12; Zech. 12:10; Rev. 1:7
 - Proof of body, God came in the flesh
- Buried v. 31-42
 - Joseph of Arimathea is given the body of Jesus by Pilate
 - Joseph and Nicodemus bury Jesus
 - Close to Golgotha in a garden
 - In a known accessible place
 - In a tomb owned, unused and hewn out by Joseph
 - It was the Jewish Day of Preparation
 - They buried Him there
