

## Judah's Rejection and Israel's National Restoration

- Prodigal Son and Elder Brother Luke 15:11-32
  - The Son demanding his own, Jeroboam/Ephraim 975 BC Psalm 81:11-13
    - \$\$\$, wasted in dissipation
    - Ephraim's sin brought death to the House of Israel
  - The Son taken to the far county, Sargon II 722 BC
    - Scattered, Not having obtained mercy and Divorced Hosea 1
  - The Father Waiting for a repentant son
  - The Son recognizes the condition he placed himself in
    - Greed, lust, corruption, rejection of Father
  - The Son seeks mercy, it was always there Hosea 1:9-10; Jeremiah 50:4-5 Lev. 26:40-42
    - The Robe Isaiah 61:10; Revelation 19:7,8
    - The Ring Genesis 42:41
    - The Shoes Ephesians 6:15
  - The jealous older brother (Jonah is the Type here)
    - Rejects God plan for Israel's redemption
    - Rejects God
    - Rejects the Savior
    - Rejects his own inheritance
    - Rejects his brother
    - And in complete anger lies to his Father
- Rich Man and Lazarus - Luke 16:19-31
  - Rich man, clothed in purple, fine linen, sumptuous everyday life
    - The type of the house of Judah
    - Money was his god and he could order his god around
    - Compassion zero
    - Jesus said this type have their reward, here only
  - Lazarus, the type of the House of Israel
    - Divested of all goods because of dissipation
    - Romans 9:31-9-11
  - Abraham, the covenant bearer for all Israel
    - Luke 1:68-75; Romans 15:8
  - The Abyss—The Separation of Israel and Judah created by Christ Jesus
