

# Kingdom Transfer

- Wicked Husbandmen, Householder and Heir Matt. 21:33-46; Mark 12:1-12; Luke 20:9-19
  - The Parable Cast
    - Householder= God (LORD of the vineyard)
    - Planted Vineyard= Israel, the Kingdom
    - Husbandmen= Kings and Priesthood
    - Servants= Prophets
    - Heir= Christ Jesus (King of Kings)
  - Jesus asks the Chief Priests and Pharisees
    - What should the Householder DO?
    - Response: kill the wicked men and rent the vineyard to others
  - Jesus says: That sounds good to me
    - The Kingdom will be taken from you Isaiah 5:1-25; 63:3
    - Given to a nation that bears fruits of righteous faith
      - 1 Peter 2:4-9
      - Transferred Kingdom, Crushing Stone Kingdom
  - And the chief Priests and Pharisees PERCEIVED that He spoke of them
- Kingdom Purchased for Israel
  - Hidden Treasure Matthew 13:44
    - The Kingdom of Heaven is like treasure hidden in a field
    - Discoverer, expert in values, sacrificial purchaser, profit-seeker
      - Luke 4:5-7; Psalm 130:8; 1 Peter 1:19; Matthew 20:28
    - The Son of Man Matthew 15:24; Isaiah 9:7; John 10:1-18; Ezekiel 37
  - Pearl of Great Price Matthew 13:45-46
    - 2 Cor. 8:9; Phil. 2:8; Col. 2:3; Isaiah 53:5; Acts 20:28; Eph. 1:17-19
