

## Leviticus 2:1-16; 6:14-18; 7:9-10 The Grain Offering

- Israel's Circumstance Duet. 6:10-12; 8:11-14; 11:10-12
  - Desert (not Egypt nor Canaan)
    - No possibility of growing grain
    - No place to buy it
  - We have manna (what is it?)
- Yet God seeks a grain offering?
  - And is telling us how to offer it
  - This is a complimentary offering, not stand alone
- Terms
  - Qorban- General term for offerings Ch. 1-7
  - Ola- Specialized term for the whole burnt offering Ch. 1
  - Minha- Technical term for the grain offering
  - Memorial portion-focus on God—Worship
  - A thing most holy-designated for the priests
- The uncooked grain offering v. 1-3
- The various cooked grain offerings v. 4-10
  - Oven, griddle, or pan
  - Bread, pancakes, sweet rolls or donuts
- Ingredients v. 11-13 (herein lies the sacrifice)
  - Fine (ground) flour, fit only for a king
    - Wheat or barley
  - Olive oil
  - Frankincense
  - Leaven-refused by God Exodus 23:18
  - Salt-required by God, covenant of salt Numbers 18:19; 2 Chron. 13:5
- Early grain offerings v. 14-16
- Principles seen in this offering
  - Dependence on God for physical needs
  - Dependence of God for spiritual necessities
  - Sacrifice
  - Support
  - Sequence
