

# Leviticus 5:14-6:7; 7:1-6 The Guilt Offering

- Guilt has two aspects
  - Legal—God and man given Gen.26:8-10
  - Emotional—God given—man manipulated
- Guilt pairs up on a legal and emotional level 4 ways
  - No legal guilt—no guilt feelings Acts 7:51
  - No legal guilt—guilt feelings (over sensitive or manipulation)
  - Legal guilt—no guilt feelings Proverbs 30:20
  - Legal guilt—guilt feelings (where repentance starts)
- Sin and Guilt are fully intermingled in Leviticus 4-7
  - Lev. 5:5-6, 15; 1 Samuel 6:1-5
- Violation of God's Holy things 5:14-16
- Guilt offering required from sinning, not knowing v. 17-19
- Guilt offering for extortion and robbery 6:1-7
- Guilt offering details 7:1-6
- God's Holy things OT
  - His name
  - Sabbath
  - Offerings and temple rites
  - National purity Ezra 9:2
- LORD'S Holy things NT
  - His name
  - The Gospel
  - Our bodies
  - The LORD's Supper 1 Cor. 10:14, 11:27
- Handling guilt
  - Train the conscience 1 Tim. 1:3,5; Heb. 5:11-12
  - We will never know ALL our sins
  - Confession is better than denial 1 John 1:9
  - When restitution is possible, make it
  - Learn your lessons, then leave it behind
- Our guilt offering is Jesus Christ
  - Justify=not guilty Hebrews 10:10-18
