

## Revelation 11: 1-14 - THE DAY OF THE LORD CONTINUES

- 7<sup>th</sup> Seal, 6<sup>th</sup> Trumpet, 2<sup>nd</sup> Woe
  - John told to measure v. 1
    - The temple and altar and people who worship in it
- John told not to measure the court v. 2
  - Given to the nations to tread
    - 42 months
- Two Witnesses v. 3-13
  - Their duty and mission
    - Prophecy for 1260 days
- Their attitude
  - Clothed in sackcloth (mourning)
- Their Identity
  - two olive trees and lampstands standing before the Lord Zech. 4:1-14
- Their power
  - Fire flowing from their mouths against any who would hurt them
  - Shutting up the sky
  - Turning water to blood
  - Plagues, at will
- Their destiny
  - Death
    - At the end of their testimony
    - The beast from the abyss makes war and overcomes and kills them
    - Their bodies left in the streets of Jerusalem
      - 3 ½ days
- The world's response
  - Celebration and gift giving
- Their resurrection
  - Given the breath of life from God and taken to heaven in everyone's sight
- The impact and reaction
  - Fear from those who watched rise to their feet and unto heaven
  - A great earth quake, 1/10 of the city structures destroyed, 7000 people killed
  - The rest remain terrified and give glory to God
- The Second Woe is past v. 14

# Revelation 11:15-19 - The Millennial Reign Begins

- 7<sup>th</sup> Seal, 7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet, 3<sup>rd</sup> Woe begins
  - The 7<sup>th</sup> Angel sounds v. 15
    - Voices from Heaven v. 15
      - Saying, "The 'cosmos' kingdom has become the Kingdom of our LORD and His CHRIST, and HE will reign forever and ever!!"
      - Judgment and coronation
      - 2 Samuel 15:10; 1 Kings 1:39; Psalm 2:6-9; Isaiah 2:2,3; Dan. 2:34-35, 44-45; 7:13-14,18,22,27; Micah 4:1-3; Zech. 14:9; Matt. 6:10; Luke 1:31-33
    - Daniel's 70<sup>th</sup> week is now complete, 7 years have passed
      - Beginning with the first seal
    - The Millennial Reign begins
    - The "Day of the Lord" judgment is not yet fully complete
    - Daniel's 30 days begin Daniel 12:11
  - Elders v. 16, 17
    - Worshiped God, for;
      - His eternal nature
      - Praise for exercising His mighty power
      - Praise for beginning the long anticipated reign of HIS Christ
  - Nations v. 18
    - RAGE
    - Wrath came Isaiah 24:17-23; 26:20-21; 30:27-33
      - Tense – past
    - Time (season) of judgment of the dead came
      - Tense – past
    - Reward to the prophets
    - Reward to the saints
    - Reward to those that fear His Name
      - small & great
    - To destroy those that destroy the earth
      - Tense – yet future – imminent
  - Temple of God
    - opened
- Ark appeared—lightening, peals of thunder, earthquake and hail
