

Revelation 14:1-20 THE LAMB STANDING ON MOUNT ZION

- The Lamb standing on Mount Zion
 - A continuation of His having come *parousia*
 - Ps. 2:6-9; 48:2; Isa. 11:9-12; 24:23; Joel 2:30-32; Zech. 14:4; Romans 11:25-28
 - Seen with the 144,000 Hebrews that were sealed Rev. 7
 - Ps. 91:5-16
 - First fruits of restored Israel Isa. 65:23
 - The 144,000 are singing a song that only they can learn
 - Given to them from heaven
 - These are the ones that follow the Lamb wherever He goes
- Three angels speak v. 6-11
 - The first angel preaching the eternal gospel including God=s judgment which is about to take place
 - The second angel speaks Babylon=s judgment and condemnation
 - The third angel speaks of damnation for those who worship the beast or his image. If you take the mark of the beast or worship himC you will taste the wrath of GodC eternally
- Then comes a warning to the Saints v. 12
 - Keep your faith in Jesus and persevere, follow the commands of God Ps. 1:1-2; Isa. 43:1-7; John 6:37-40
- A voice from heaven speaks v. 13
 - Blessed are those that die in the Lord from this point on Spirit of God says their will rest from their labors
- The Harvest of the Earth and the Vine Clusters v. 14-20
 - Son of Man, crowned with gold, ON A CLOUD, sickle in hand Daniel 7:13-14; Phil. 2:6-8; Luke 19:10; 2 Tim. 4:1
 - First, in the rapture and resurrection, CHRIST reaps his own from the earth
 - Second, the sickle angel is directed by the angel with power over FIRE to reap the clusters that are left, in wrath he gathers the cluster
 - He throws them into the great wine press of God's wrath (by exception the two witnesses and the 144,000 seen earlier) Isa. 13:11-13; 24:21-23; Joel 3:13
 - Resulting in blood rising over two hundred miles to the horses bridle.

THE DAY OF THE LORD RESUMES

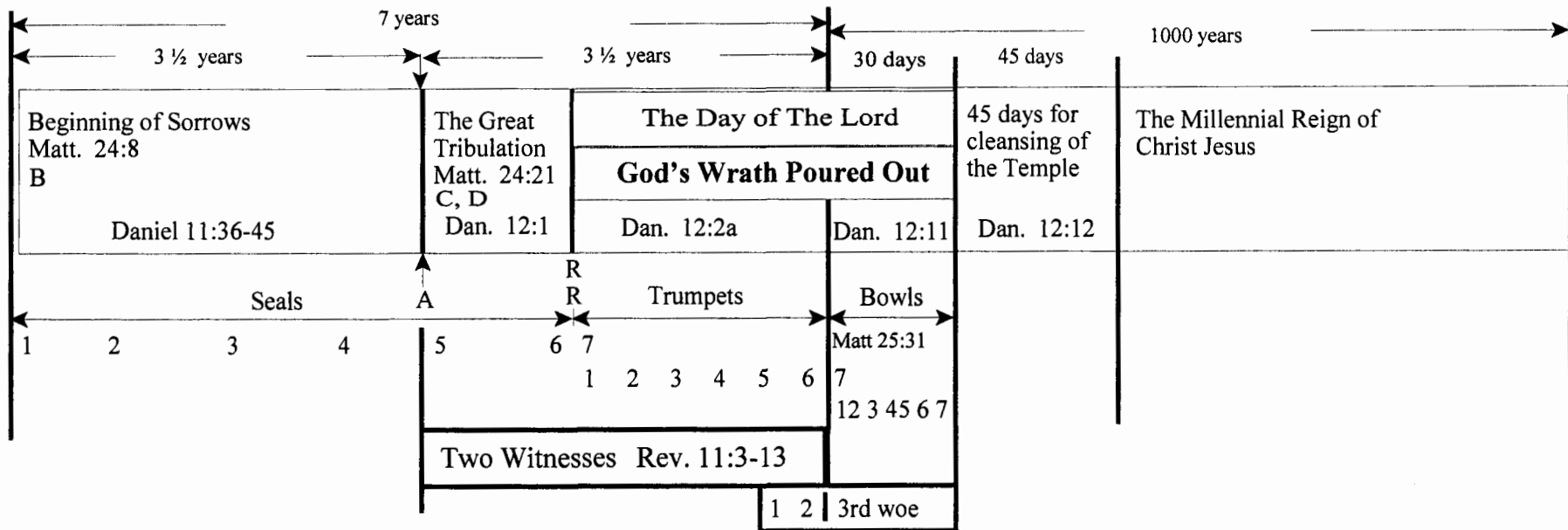
Revelation 15: 1-8

- Seven Angels with seven plagues (v. 1)
 - A sign in heaven
 - “The last of God’s wrath poured out”
 - (In this sign God’s wrath will be finished)

- A vision of the Gathered and Resurrected Church (v. 2-4)
 - In heaven the victorious multitude (Rev. 7: 9 ff)
 - on a sea of glass mixed with fire
 - holding harps
 - singing the song of Moses and the song of the Lamb a praise to God
 - “Great and marvelous are Your works, O Lord God, the Almighty; Righteous and true are Your ways, King of the nations! Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify Your name for You alone are holy; For all the nations will come and worship before You, For Your righteous acts have been revealed.”

- Seven Angels prepared and equipped to deliver God’s wrath (v. 5-8)
 - The temple opened
 - Seven angels in game dress
 - Clean and bright linen
 - Golden sashes girded around their chests
 - One of the four creatures passes out the golden bowls
 - One to each angel
 - Each bowl, a bowl of God’s wrath
 - “The temple fills with the smoke of God’s glory
 - and smoke from HIS POWER
 - The temple is then closed off until God’s wrath is complete
