

Revelation 18:1-24 FALLEN BABYLON

- An angel with great authority coming down, saying v. 1-3
 - Fallen, Fallen is Babylon the great! 2 Peter 2:9
 - Destroyed at the hands of the beast and ten horns
 - By fire Matt. 13:40-50
 - A dwelling place of demons
 - Prison for every unclean spirit
 - Nations are drunk with her passion Acts 14:16
 - Kings committing acts of immorality Ps. 2:2-4
 - Merchants getting wealthy on her sensuality
- Another voice from heaven v. 4-19
 - Come out of her, my people! 2 Cor. 6:14-17
 - Don't participate in her sins or her judgment
 - God is remembering her sins—piled up even to heaven
 - Pay back, double what she has done Ps. 137:8
 - To the degree she sinned in her sensuality
 - Torment and mourning Jer. 50:14-15,24,29,46
 - Pestilence, famine, mourning and FIRE. Dan. 5:30
 - The KINGS of the earth will weep and lament
 - At the sight of her smoke & burning
 - They will stand at a distance because of fear
 - The MERCHANTS of the earth will weep and mourn
 - No one buys their goods any more
 - They will stand at a distance because of fear
 - The shipmaster, passenger, and sailor were crying out
 - What city is like the great city?
 - They stood at a distance, crying
 - For in one hour she has been laid waste!
- Rejoice in her judgment v. 20
 - GOD HAS...pronounced FOR YOU—against her
 - Heaven...saints...apostles...prophets
- Babylon will be crushed and destroyed v. 21-24
 - A strong angel shows John
 - A great millstone thrown into the sea
 - With the same violence Babylon—will be destroyed
 - With the same quickness she will come to an end
 - She will be destroyed forever—Why? Luke 12:16-21
 - She seduced the merchants & nations
 - The blood of prophets and saints were found in her
