

Revelation 19: 1-10 HALLELUJAH, HE'S COME

- First Hallelujah v. 1
 - Salvation (specifically glorification) has come
 - Glory and power belong to God
 - Ps 104:35; Ps. 113-118
- Justice is meted out v. 2
 - Righteous and true are His judgments
 - He judged the great harlot
 - Satan=s religious, political and economic world systems
 - He avenged the blood of the saints
 - Deut. 32:42-43; 2 Thess. 1:6-8
- Second Hallelujah v. 3
 - The judgment of Babylon is eternal
 - Mark 9:48; Rev. 14:10
- Third and Fourth Hallelujah v. 4-6
 - The Elders and four living creatures agree
 - A voice invites His Bond-Servants to join the praise
 - In response—they praise God who reigns eternally
- The marriage is now to be complete v. 7-8
 - The bride is ready
 - Authorized to wear fine, bright and clean linen
 - By her righteous acts
 - Blessed are those that are invited to the marriage supper
 - These are true words of God!
- John mistakenly worships the angel showing him this v. 9-10
 - John receives a rebuke (be discerning in your worship)
 - The Testimony of Jesus is the Spirit of proper teaching
 - We have been redeemed to worship God and Him through His Son Jesus Christ, this is God=s eternal purpose

Revelation 19:11-21 HEAVEN OPENED, OH, OUR GLORIOUS WARRIOR KING COMES

- The Conquering King Comes v. 11-13
 - Heaven opened, BEHOLD Matt. 24:27-31
 - Rider: Sitting on a white horse
 - Name: Faithful and True Rev. 3:14
 - He judges and makes war
 - Eyes: a flame of fire Rev. 1:14
 - Head: many diadems 2 Samuel 12:30
 - Name: written, known only to Him
 - Clothed: robe dipped in blood Isa. 63:1-6
 - Name: THE Word of God John 1:1, 14
- His Army v. 14
 - Clothed in white linen
 - Riding white horses too
- His Rule v. 15-16
 - A sharp sword from His mouth
 - To strike the nations (in judgment)
 - A rod of iron
 - To rule the nations (in righteousness)
 - Wrath belongs to Him Joel 3:12-14
 - He treads the wine press of God=s wrath
 - NAME: KING OF KINGS, LORD OF LORDS
 - on His robe and thigh
- His Victory v. 17-21
 - Birds called by an angel, Come!
 - The Great Supper Ezekiel 39:12; Rev. 14:19, 20
 - Kings & commanders
 - Horses & riders
 - Free & slave
 - Small & great
 - Zeph. 1:14-18
 - Assembled for war against The Warrior King
 - But bam! The beast and the false prophet are thrown in the lake of fire! Matt. 25:41
 - The armies of demonically led rebellion are leaderless
 - The rest killed instantly by the sword (the word) that comes from the mouth of Christ Jesus Zech. 14:1-13
